LATERAL RESTRICTIONS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Gaines has created Water District No. 7 pursuant to Town Law for the express purpose of providing public water supply to residents along portions of Crandall and Lattin Roads; and

WHEREAS, part of the land area within Water District No. 7 is also within Orleans County Agricultural District No. 3; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has filed a Notice of Intent to Undertake an Action Within an Agricultural District and to evaluate the impact of providing a source of public water supply within this area on lands within Agricultural District No. 3; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets has expressed concern about the potential adverse impact that said public water supply is likely to have on agriculture within the Agricultural District;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Gaines, in recognition of the concerns that have been raised, hereby resolves to limit connections to the public water supply only to existing non-farm uses and to farm-related uses within that portion of Water District No. 7 which is also within the limits of Orleans County Agricultural District No. 3.
