Supervisor DeCarlo read the following :

ARTICLE IL IMPOSITION OF MORATORIUM

Section 201: Imposition of Moratorium

For a period of Three Hundred Sixty Five (365) days after the date of filing this local law with the Department of State, no application or erection of wind energy deriving towers, meteorological towers or transmission facilities may be filed nor will any application be accepted or proceed, with the exception of windmills utilized for irrigation proposes with a constricted height of thirty five (35) feet or less, as well as test towers utilized to determine the viability of the siting of wind energy deriving towers. The height of said test towers is to be set through the application and permit process. The permit granting the construction of said test towers shall limit the life of the test tower to two (2) years measured from the date the permit is granted by the town with the option of extending the life of said test tower. The permit will be contingent upon the filing of a performance bond by the applicant to insure the removal of the tower at the conclusion of the permit period.

The number of test towers shall be limited to a total of four (4) within the Town of Gaines for the period of this moratorium. Permit applicant shall reimburse the town for the administration costs associated with the project.

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that such action is a "Type 1" action under the provisions of SEAR and authorized the issuance of a Negative Declaration indicating that such action will not result in significant environmental impacts;

WHEREAS, it is now the intent and desire of the Town Board to adopt Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2006, now therefore, be it

RESOVLED, that Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2006 of the Town of Gaines, Orleans County, New York, being a local law entitled "The Town of Gaines Moratorium on Wind Energy Deriving Towers, Meteorological Towers and Transmission Facilities Law," be and the same is hereby adopted.
