Chairman Burke briefly went through the application with the applicant and fellow board members and read a letter from the applicant's neighbor, Rick DePeters, granting his permission for the barn to be built within 5 feet of his property. After a few questions about the exact location, water (no water to the barn), driveway (made with stone and may not go all the way back to the barn) and the electricity (overhead, 200 amp, if a pole is needed the applicant already has one) the application was put to a vote.

The area variance is granted to Charles Monacelli to build a pole barn that is located five feet (right setback and rear setback) from his property line and he can get a building permit from Code Enforcement Officer Robert McGaffick. As of now Mr. Monacelli believes he will go with overhead electric lines, if this changes he is to let the Town know.

It was noted that the variance stays with the property regardless of new owners for either Mr. Moncelli's property or Mr. DePeters property.

With no further business on a motion from Vice-Chairman Syck, seconded by Member Strickland the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
