"RESOLVED, that in accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) regulations, the Town Board of the Town of Gaines hereby announces its intent to serve as lead agency to conduct an environmental review of a project to construct a series of public water supply improvements to serve the Town of Gaines Water District No. 8. The project involves the installation of approximately 10,670 feet of 8-inch watermain within the rights-of-way of Zig Zag Road, Densmore Road and West Transit Church Road. The proposed project would provide public water to residents of this area who are currently dependent on individual wells that produce an inadequate supply of poor quality water.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board has determined that, as portions of the project are located in Orleans County Agricultural District No. 3, the proposed action is a Type I action as defined under SEQR; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby accepts the Environmental Assessment of this project, prepared by Stuart I. Brown Associates, Inc., and be it
